



Green Guidance for Stall Holders / Entertainers / Caterers

Food & Drink

- **Don't** use single use plastic. This includes: plastic bags, stirrers, straws, condiment sachets, milk pots.
- **Do** provide the option to fill customers' reusable food and drink containers. *Did you know* that wood and paper has a higher carbon footprint than plastic?
- **Do** use **home** compostable cutlery, cups, plates, bowls and stirrers. *Please note* that some eco products need special heat process composting and are not suitable for domestic composting.
- **Do** try and source ethical products, such as Fairtrade products.
- **Do** use local and seasonal produce where possible.
- **Do** source meat and dairy products that have good welfare standards, such as free range or organic.
- **Do** offer a range of vegetarian / vegan options.
- **Do** try and source local organic drinks.
- **Do** source products from traders who are committed to sustainable practices, and hold relevant accreditation.

Non Food Products

- **Don't** package items in single use plastic bags or paper.
- **Don't** sell balloons, they will not be allowed on site.
- **Do** encourage customers to use their own bags. *Did you know* that you need to use a paper bag 4 to 5 times before it has a lower carbon footprint than plastic?
- **Do** provide tote bags for customers to purchase.

Entertainers

- **Don't** give away balloons or single use plastics as prizes.
- **Don't** leave a generator idling unnecessarily.
- **Do** use biodegradable glitter.
- **Do** try and use hybrid generators, especially when purchasing new ones or hiring.
